NATIONALISM



Nationalism means feeling proud of your country and its identity.

In Mexico, people feel proud of their history, traditions and culture.

Students learn about important historical events and national heroes, which helps develop this sense of national identity.





Patriotism

- Patriotism means to love and respect the country we are from, not thinking is perfect, but wanting to improve as a community.

Solidarity

Solidarity means helping and supporting others. In mexican culture this is really important and people often work together



Solidarity

- Solidarity is very visible in Mexican society. For example, during earthquakes or other disasters people volunteer and help those in need. Communities often work together to support each other.





Values



In Mexico these values are taught in schools.

Students currently learn about history of Mexico and important national heroes.
