- Chef José Andrés and World Central Kitchen served over 3.5 million meals after Hurricane Maria.

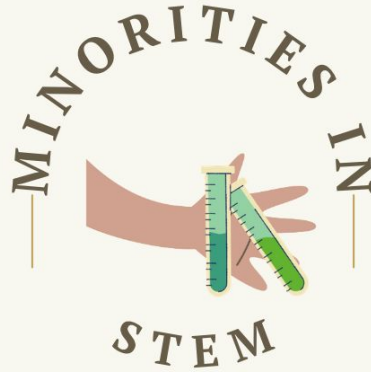
-Less Funding for minority institutions
